2011 Governor's Award Application

Philosophy

This \$1,000 scholarship is designed to provide recognition and financial assistance to a graduate student who has been a member of the Pennsylvania District of Circle K International. This award is made possible through the generosity of Pennsylvania Kiwanis Clubs that presented the 2010-11 Governor Susan C. Gräb with monetary gifts during her official Governor's Visits.

Qualifications

- Applicant must be a student at an accredited college or university when he or she applies. Applicant may be a current undergraduate student who will attend graduate school in Fall 2011 or a current graduate student who will continue graduate school in Fall 2011.
- Applicant should have a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale.

Application Procedures

All applicants must submit:

- The official application form (two pages)
- A copy of current FAFSA form
- An official college or university transcript to include GPA
- A letter detailing the Graduate Studies/Specialized Studies
- Proof of membership in a Pennsylvania Circle K Club (e.g. Member ID Number)
- A written essay of 200 words or less: "Why you are deserving of this scholarship?"
- A written essay of 150 words or less: "What are your future professional plans/goals?"

Please note: if all items requested are not included, the application will not be considered. The application with all supporting documents must be postmarked no later than the deadline date on the application form. All application materials received by the Scholarship Committee of the Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation shall become its property and will not be returned.

Selection Procedure

- All complete applications will be reviewed and judged on the information provided by the Foundation Scholarship Committee.
- This Committee will choose the best applicant, taking into consideration: FAFSA information, academics, service, leadership, and citizenship as reflected in the application documents. The scholarship recipient will be notified by mail by July. Selection of the recipient and payment thereof will be determined solely by the Scholarship Committee of the Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation. This decision of the committee is final.
