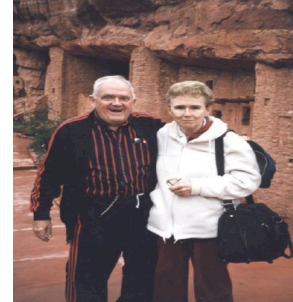




**DON and MYRT NIEMAN ENDOWED

Application ( \$1,000.00 )**



**PHILOSOPHY**

This scholarship is designed to provide recognition and financial assistance to a graduate student who is pursuing a degree in journalism or music. Don Nieman was a member of the Glenside Kiwanis Club and a member of the Pennsylvania District Kiwanis Foundation Board for several years.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

- Applicant must be a graduate student when he/she applies, and has a major in journalism or music from an accredited college or university and plans to continue in one of these fields as a graduate student.
- Applicant should have a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

All applicants must submit:

- The official application form
- **A copy of current FAFSA form**
- An official college or university transcript to include GPA.
- A letter detailing the Graduate Studies/Specialized Studies, **preferably in journalism or music.**
- **Must have been a member of the Kiwanis family** - Service Leadership Program of Kiwanis prior to graduate school; i.e. Key Club, Circle K, Aktion Club etc.
- This scholarship is limited to the **PA DISTRICT OF KIWANIS**
- A written essay of 200 words or less on: *Why you are deserving of this scholarship.*
- *Please describe your future professional plans/goals (150 words)*
- *Submit a sample of journalism/CD/DVD of a music performance that is an example of your studies.*

**NOTE:** if all items requested are not included, the application will not be considered.

The application with all supporting documents must be postmarked no later than the deadline date on the application form.

All application materials received by the Scholarship Committee of the Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation shall become its property and will not be returned.

**SELECTION PROCEDURE**

- All complete applications will be reviewed and judged on the information provided by the **Foundation Scholarship Committee.**
- This **Committee** will choose the best applicant, taking into consideration: **FAFSA information**, academics, service, leadership, and citizenship as reflected in the application documents. The scholarship recipient will be notified by mail by July. Selection of the recipient and payment thereof will be determined solely by the Scholarship Committee of the Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation. This decision of the committee is final.
